Summer Camp Leadership Team

RESPONSIBLE TO: DCC Program Committee and Camp Directors

Summary:

Members of the Summer Camp Leadership Team prepare for and lead summer camp programs at DCC.

Responsibilities:

- Prior to the beginning of summer camp, the leadership team will be involved with the selection of cabin counselors and preparing them for their camp roles.
- Leaders will facilitate summer camp programming, including keeping activities on schedule, ringing the bell, supervising staff, and ensuring that safety rules are followed. Some tasks may be delegated, but it is the Leaders' responsibility to ensure the smooth running of each program.
- Produce a camper slideshow and newsletter to be shown/distributed at the end of each session.
- Administer camp evaluation surveys of campers and staff. Results should be sealed and delivered to the Program Committee.
- Prepare a summer camp summary report for the Program Committee after the conclusion of the final camp.
- Write a summary article for a report distributed to camp members in November.
- Communicate daily with camp administrators, food service director and caretakers.

Qualifications:

- A Christian faith compatible with the Confession of Faith in a Mennonite Perspective
- Leadership and Christian camping experience
- Good listening and communication skills
- Ability to be impartial
- Ability to provide support and guidance for staff and campers
- Ability to confront counselors, teen volunteers or campers who are not performing up to their potential
- Flexibility
- A genuine interest in working with and caring for young people and children at camp
- Enjoyment of people and enthusiasm for life
- An understanding of the camp safety and health regulations, and emergency procedures
