Mystery Quilt by Trish Mayhew \$20

Advanced beginner and above

Starts Friday at 9am, join at any time

Size 60" x 84"

2 5/8 yd of dark or contrasting solid fabric

1 1/2 yd medium colored -Large print fabric

1 3/8 yd medium colored - medium print fabric

1 1/8 yd light solid/ tone on tone or small print fabric

1 yd light colored solid/ tone on tone or small print fabric (this should be different than first light fabric)

Tips

Use non directional fabric. You DO NOT know how your fabric will be cut and recut and recut
Pre-cutting instructions will be sent after you have registered for the class. Prefill several bobbins ahead of retreat. HAVE FUN!!!



Twister Table Runner by Eilene Snyder \$20

Advanced beginner and above

Friday morning, may repeat on Saturday morning

Size: 14" x 40"

Fabric:

Charm pack (or cut your own 5" squares)

5/8 yd background /border

1/4 yd inner border

2/3 yd outer border/binding

3/4 yd backing (optional)

Lil Twister tool – Important template



Double nine-patch by Annette Mandel \$35

39" and 16" x 36"

All day Saturday

This class is for beginners. Learn to strip piece, match seams, add cornerstones and sashing, put on borders. Make a table runner or baby quilt/wallhanging as you pick up some basic skills.

Supplies:

Sewing machine you can thread yourself

1 1/4 yards main fabric

3/4 yard secondary fabric (sashing and inner border)

1/2 yard accent fabric

Basic sewing supplies

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Pineapple Nine Patch – by Lynn McCamant \$35

Intermediate and advanced class

Friday all day

Size 84" x 97". A smaller 71" x 84" size or table runner could also be created.

Book: Geometric Gems by Cathy Wierzbicki, from That Patchwork Place

Tools: Tri-Recs Rulers, or can use templates in back of book. The rulers can be quite helpful for other projects.

Let Lynn know if you would like to purchase a book and template from her. You may purchase the book for \$15.20 (20% off \$18.99) or Tri Rec set for \$12.75 (20% off \$15.89) from Lynn

Fabric:

1/2 yard each of 12 neutrals

1/2 yard each of 12 Non-neutral

Note: The quilt in the book is done in Neutrals and Reds. For a more scrappy look, the more different fabrics there are to choose from the better. If you have more than 12 neutrals and 12 "Reds" you would not need as much yardage of each.

If there is time before retreat, precutting the strips and some sewing some together will be helpful.
