Teen Volunteer Job Description

Summary

Drift Creek Camp's Teen Volunteer Program is designed to introduce teens to the responsibilities of camp leadership. Positions are available to youth ages 13-17, with or without prior camp experience. Our goal is to form a foundational experience of Christian service that will help to equip students for future ministry opportunities. This position will challenge teens to develop an attitude of service, responsibility, discipline, spiritual growth, and working with peers as well as in supportive roles alongside counselors.

Responsibilities

- Model a committed Christian life before campers, other staff and volunteers.
- Share in the responsibility of making camp a great experience; *understanding campers are priority.*
- Greet campers and parents at registration day; assist with check-in & escort campers to cabins.
- Participate in a rotating daily schedule of dishes, cleaning (including bathrooms), assistance with childcare and various duties requested by camp staff.
- Maintain an attitude of flexibility and availability.
- Attend fireside and chapel whenever it does not conflict with assigned duties.
- Contribute to a spirit of unity, teamwork, and loyalty among staff.
- Be a part of a daily discipleship-oriented Bible study time.
- Be self-motivated to make sure your duties are done promptly and to the best of your ability.
- Maintain a Christ-like attitude in words, dress, and actions; *remembering that respect is key.*
- Be in your assigned rooms and prepared for rest at the designated lights out time. Adequate sleep is vital to excellence. Be prepared to rise at the appropriate time to begin morning duties.

Items You Provide

- Transportation to and from Drift Creek Camp
- A wrist watch and battery-powered alarm clock so you can be on-time for assignments
- Warm sleeping bag and pillow
- Sturdy shoes for outdoor work, comfortable closed-toe shoes for long days in the kitchen, and creek shoes for assisting with water activities
- Warm jacket, sweatshirt, long-sleeved shirts, and pants
- Rain Gear
- Insect repellent
- Personal toiletries and towels
- Bathing suit (one piece) or swim shorts
- Bible, notebook, pen/pencil
- Flashlight and camera
- **Please do not bring ipods, boom boxes, or other personal electronic devices**

NOTE: The maximum number of Teen Volunteers each week is eight.
